What we have on the ballot today is the School Budget and Board of Education Candidates.

If you received the Waterford Halfmoon <u>UFSD 2024-25 Budget Newsletter</u>, you already know that the school tax levy is being increased by a 0.99%. For full information, visit the <u>WHUFSD website</u>, where a <u>power point presentation</u> breaks the budget down to comprehensible terms. As explained in the presentation, this would result in an increase of \$27 on a home assessed at \$150,000.

As noted in slide 7 of the presentation, "any attempt to determine tax rates in May must be regarded as strictly an estimate." Actual tax rates cannot be determined at this time because:
